



Henry J Dryovage Jr. is an internationally known animator. He worked on *World Beyond War*, a premier simulcast that connected 7 continents with satellite technology. In addition, he produced the animated graphics for the *International World Cup Soccer Tournament*. Other broadcast market projects include the development of flying logos for television commercials for the *49ers*, *Northern California Honda Dealers*, and the *Bay Area Oldsmobile Dealers "Go Olds"* promotion, *Hewlett Packard* and *TRW*. Produced character animations for *General Motors / Campbell - Ewald Advertising*, and contributed to *Apple Computer's* roll out of a new line of laptops with a logo treatment.

Mr. Dryovage began his animation and effects career in the San Francisco (*south of Market District*). First using traditional arts and crafts techniques, working with a team of modelers building miniatures of the San Francisco financial district. This enabled the *Lucas Film Studio* to fly a motion-controlled camera over the Bay Bridge, up Market Street, and into your home if you lived in the North Beach district! The "*When You Need News*" show, produced for *NBC/KRON-TV*, in San Francisco won an Emmy, three Clio nominations, and Best Broadcast Design Award from the BDA.

Currently Henry is a Level II certified *Softimage 3D* instructor, recently developed and taught a number of Computer Graphic courses at *Lawrence Technological University*. Now a 7 year veteran and master of the Art of Maya for animation at the College for Creative Studies. Dryovage has teaching assignments at Henry Ford, Macomb and Washtenaw Community Colleges, and a freelance consultant.

Recently Mr. Dryovage served the Walled Lake Central Public High School, in an Artist in Residence program. He is scheduling a re[peat performance at the Detroit Country Day High School, where he will organize and assist students at developing a Film and Animation Club.
